2	this, please?
3	THE COURT: This is Channel 6. You say
4	channel, camera 6.
5	(PLAYING VIDEO)
6	THE COURT: Is that Davis in the video in the
7	back or no?
8	MS. WALSH: No, Your Honor. No, it's not, to
9	my knowledge, Your Honor.
10	MR. KNIZLEY: Is that Harry Matthews?
11	THE COURT: While we're watching this, tell
12	me, who is Harry Matthews? What is his role in
13	this?
14	MR. KNIZLEY: He is the State's witness that
15	was here yesterday in the court. All I know so far
16	has rented the hotel rooms and appears to be in the
17	videos from time to time.
18	THE COURT: Just pause it. Who is Harry
19	Matthews? What's his role in this case?
20	MS. RICH: Your Honor, Harry Matthews and
21	Christopher Davis went to high school together at
22	BC Rain. Harry Matthews is Christopher Davis's
23	brother-in-law. Christopher Davis is married to
24	Harry Matthews' sister.
25	THE COURT: Okay.

MS. RICH: And they've been friends for a long time. So just to set all this up, Your Honor, this is what we will proffer will happen on the stand is that Harry Matthews, about a week or two before, they have two other friends from high school that are in the military. One is in the military in California, don't quote me on the branches, one is in the military in South Carolina, and they were coming home for this particular weekend. Okay.

And so Harry Matthews says, let's get together, haven't seen them, blah, blah, blah, and Harry Matthews rents the hotel room. The two friends from the military come into town. Harry Matthews has rented the hotel room, and they're having a get-together.

At around 11:30, Christopher Davis finds out through Facebook that Harry Matthews has these friends that he hasn't seen either from the military that are in town. So he gets on the phone with Harry Matthews and Harry says, yeah, we're having a get-together at the Comfort Inn.

So Christopher Davis, his wife and child all go to the -- and the State had no knowledge of any of this, Your Honor, until the trial began, because

Christopher Davis has not been cooperative with the State nor with the Defense. Okay. We lawfully subpoenaed him. He honored his subpoena, and we did not know any of this that I am telling you until this week during trial when Christopher Davis showed up as a witness. Okay. That's very important.

The only thing either side knew about

Christopher Davis's testimony is State's Exhibit

Number 190, which is a written statement that he

prepared. He refused to give Detective McCullough

an interview. He refused to talk to anyone at all.

He came down to the police station with his uncle

Alfred Davis and he gave this written statement in

the -- what the State knew about any of this, nor

the Defense.

And so when he comes in, this is when we learn everything that I am telling you now. So he, his wife and his child arrive at the Comfort Inn in the car. Okay. That's the video that will be played in a minute that has been given to the Defense.

And so Christopher Davis is there from sometime, 11:30 -- I'm sorry, sometime, 12:30, 10 minutes. You know, he's arriving at the time that

the crash occurs, so that's around 12:40 in the 1 2 morning. Okay. And he is only there until 1:23 on Officer Estes' body camera. That's it. That's the 3 4 extent of Christopher Davis being at this hotel, period. 5 6 THE COURT: Did the Defense ever issue a 7 Subpoena Duces Tecum to the hotel for all their surveillance videos? 8 9 MR. KNIZLEY: No, sir. 10 THE COURT: Why not? 11 MR. KNIZLEY: We didn't realize the 12 importance of it at that time. I mean, we got 13 produced everything -- the State goes and produces 14 -- grabs all the videos and produces what they have here and that is what we understand --15 16 THE COURT: I'm not critical of anybody. just trying to find out the dynamics of who did 17 18 what pretrial. You had some videos, so you had some videos from the hotel. 19 20 MR. KNIZLEY: One. 21 THE COURT: One. 22 MR. KNIZLEY: It was other channels. The video 23 of importance is the video on the road, okay, and 24 we knew nothing about the other videos that the 25

State had taken. The State had given us a bunch of

videos, but these were the ones that were left out.

MS. RICH: Your Honor, just so I may continue with the party, okay. And so Christopher Davis leaves at 1:20. Then there's Facebook photos that were sent at 1:40 to Christopher Davis of three people. I don't know who they are, they're not Christopher Davis, they're all males, black males.

THE COURT: Sent from who to Christopher Davis?

MS. RICH: Sent in a group chat to and

McCullough can tell you who, from some person to a

bunch of people, including Christopher Davis, of

guys sleeping in their throw-up, but that has

nothing to do with Christopher Davis. Okay. And

that was after Christopher Davis had left with his

wife and his child. And so they have no

relevance whatsoever, no bearing on this case and

we can argue that later, but I just need you to lay

the foundation of this.

THE COURT: I just wanted to know who the other guy was. I got it. All right. So go ahead and keep playing.

MS. WALSH: Judge, I will just note, for the record, the timestamp is 11:53:14 p.m.
